**MEMORANDUM ON PROPOSED TARIFF LEGISLATION
of the 109th Congress¹**

Nature of bill: Temporary duty suspension through 12/31/2008.

Retroactive effect: None.

Suggested article description(s) for enactment (including appropriate HTS subheading(s)):

Ion-exchange resin powder comprised of a copolymer of methacrylic acid cross-linked with divinylbenzene, in the hydrogen ionic form, of a nominal particle size between 0.025mm and 0.150 mm, dried to less than 5% moisture (CAS No. 50602-21-6) (provided for in subheading 3914.00.60).

Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:

The proponent imports this ion-exchange resin under the trade name Amberlite® IRP64. The product is characterized as an insoluble, weakly acidic, hydrogen form, positively charged cation exchange resin used in the pharmaceutical industry as a carrier for certain drugs and as a stabilizer for other drugs. Examples are for the stabilization of vitamin B₁₂ and the sustained release of nicotine. The proponent's product is manufactured and imported from Chauny, France.

A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on a certain ion exchange resin powder.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ION EXCHANGE RESIN POWDER.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following:

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1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
